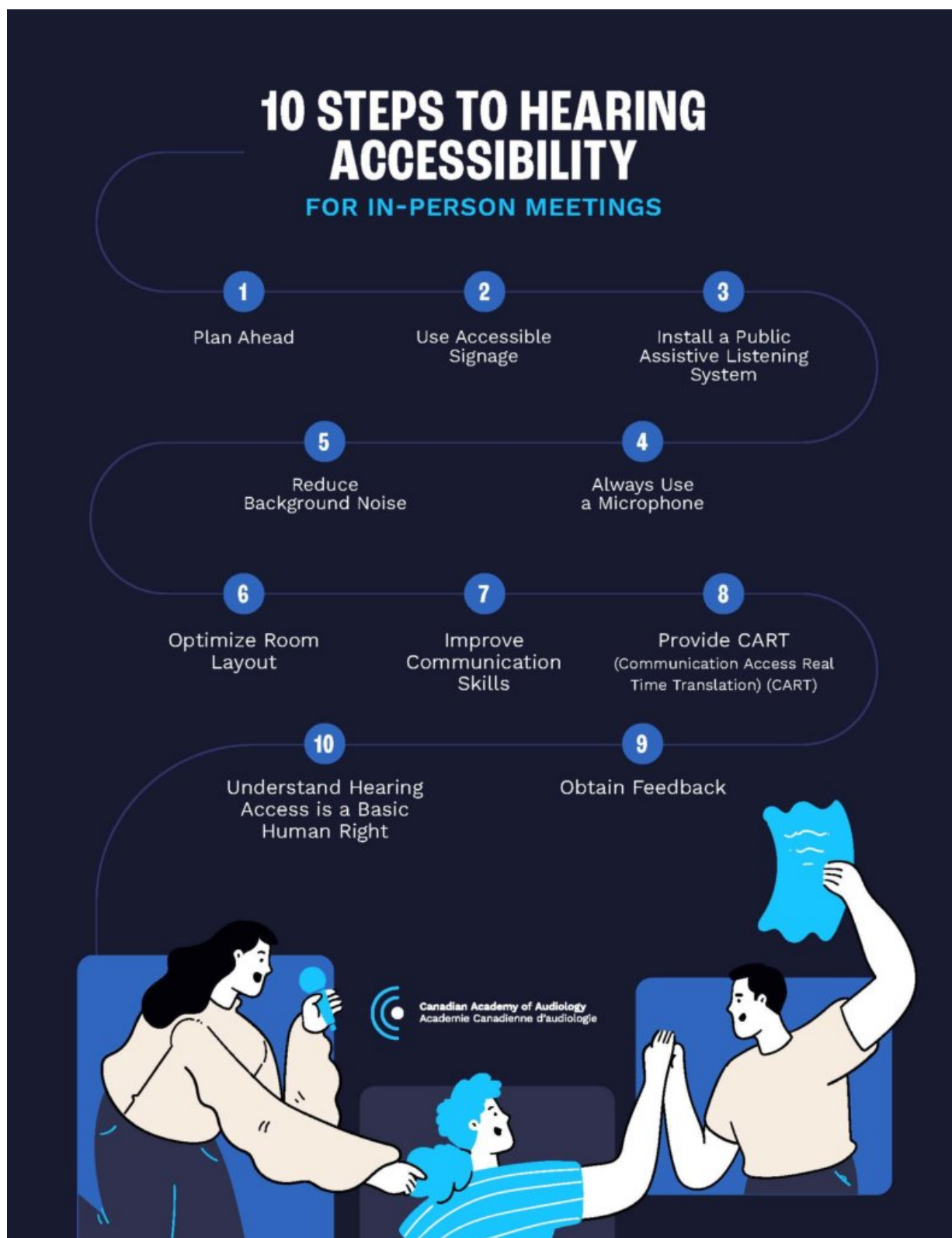

- 10 Comprendre que bien entendre est un droit humain fondamental

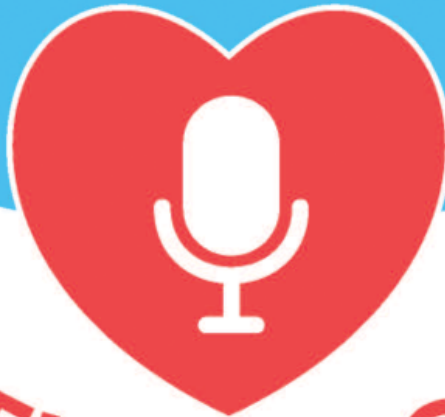
