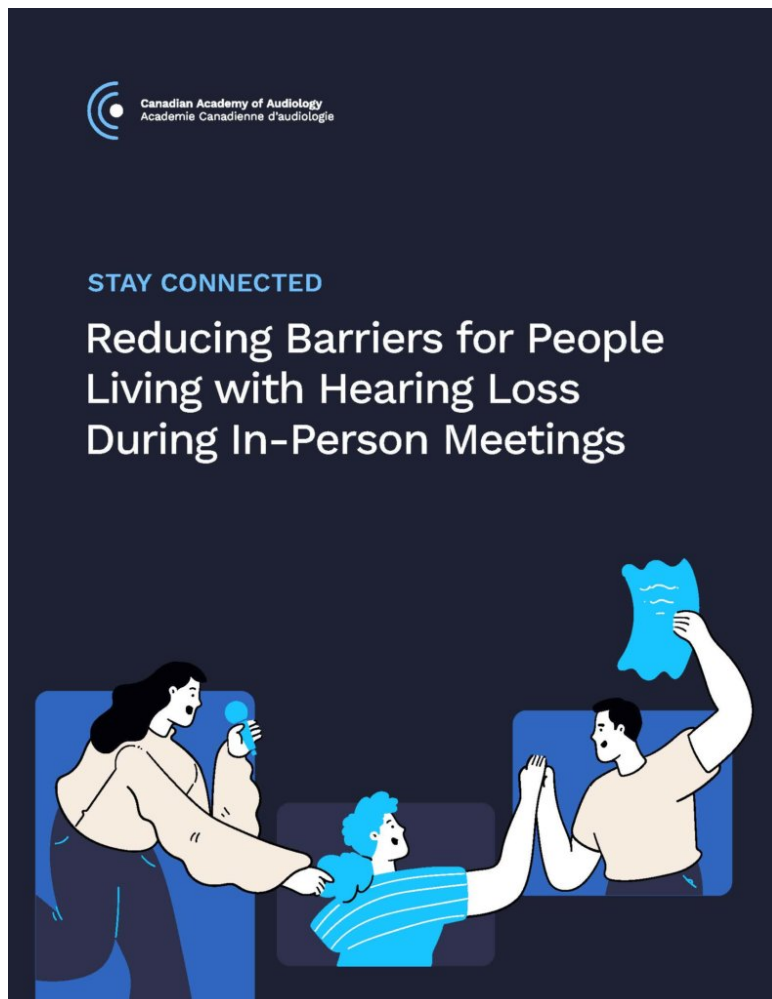

- 3 Install a Public Assistive Listening System
- 4 Always Use a Microphone
- 5 Reduce Background Noise
- 6 Optimize Room Layout
- 7 Improve Communication Skills
- 8 Provide CART (Communication Access Real Time Translation) (CART)
- 9 Obtain Feedback
- 10 Understand Hearing Access is a Basic Human Right
